LOCATION

We are located in the fully air-conditioned facilities at The Center of Clayton, Clayton High School and the beautiful outdoor areas of Shaw Park. All of these facilities provide the ideal setting for summer fun. Facilities include two indoor pools and one outdoor pool with a diving tank, seven athletic fields, four basketball courts, one indoor and two outdoor volleyball courts and 10 tennis courts, as well as fine art studios, theaters, science labs, computer labs and even a rock climbing wall!

The above fees are per two-week session. A deposit equivalent to one session fee is required at the time of registration to secure your place in camp. Full payment is required by May 31, 2016, for all sessions. Although we expect to fill all available spaces, full refunds will be granted before May 1, 2016. A \$100 withdrawal fee will be assessed for campers withdrawing between May 1 and May 31, 2016. Withdrawals after May 31, 2016, incur full tuition charges for all sessions. Exceptions to these payment policies will be granted for medical disability.
